misuse of the password, if at all the password falls in the hands of unauthorized  
person/s.

Sub: Undertaking required to be furnished by dealers to the  
Local Vat Office / VAT Sub Office-reg.

Ref: Your letter dated 17.10.2011.

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In your letter cited above, you have requested for deletion of paragraphs 3 and 4 in the undertaking to be filed by the dealers so as to continue to avail e-Sugam facility. It has been stated that small dealers depend on others to avail e-Sugam facility and the consequence of any misuse by others should not burden small dealers.

The matter is examined. The undertaking required to be furnished by dealers is a measure taken to protect and safeguard the interests of the dealer to whom 'username ' and 'password' has been issued. 'Username ' and 'password' has been issued to all the active registered dealers to facilitate filing of returns and avail other e-services extended by the department. Certain dealers may not be downloading any forms but it is necessary for such dealer also to take adequate security measures to prevent possible misuse of 'username ' and 'password' by persons to whom they divulge the details. The undertaking sought by the department in this regard is only to caution the dealers of the possible misuse of their 'username ' and 'password' and to take preventive measures .

Paragraphs 3 and 4 of the declaration will be enforced if the dealer is found to have indulged in misuse of 'Username ' and 'password' issued to him.

In the circumstances, I request you to enlighten your members about the consequences of possible misuse of 'Username ' and 'password' and the purpose of the undertaking sought from the LVOs /VSOs and cooperate with the department to continue to extend services to the dealers .
